*The groups of French language will be defined according to a level test done at the beginning of the semester. French as a Foreign Language (FLE) comprises:

- 4 hours a week over 11 weeks (44h) in each semester for the A and B groups (beginner and intermediate level).
- 2 hours a week over 11 weeks (22h) in each semester for the C and D groups (and potentially E advanced level).

In addition to the courses required by the program, students in groups A & B who wish to do so may choose to take one or more lectures in French. These courses will be credited with 3 ECTS

^{**}Students registered in FLE groups C, D & E will choose a general lecture in French (Cours Magistral), English classes excluded, among the classes of 1st, 2nd and 4th year levels, that is compatible with their schedule. This class will account for 3 ECTS per semester.
