In 2019, Sciences Po Rennes created a unit whose mission was to listen, to assist in the qualification of the facts and the constitution of a file, and to direct towards the appropriate contacts.

This unit is open to all students and staff members of the school.

You will then be offered a telephone or Zoom interview with two members of the listening unit. This interview will allow you to be listened to, accompanied and directed towards the competent services, depending on your situation (psychologist, doctor, lawyer, consulate, etc.).

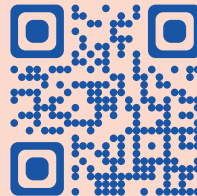

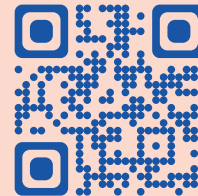
Page of the monitoring and listening unit
